 June 12, 2007


- A Chairman Barber called the duly posted regular meeting of the Building Advisory Board to order at 5:10 p.m. in the Community Development Conference Room. Meeting Time & Place
- B MEMBERS PRESENT: Jon Barber, James Garner, Herm Holtz, Don Monteath and Rob Myer (arrived late). ABSENT: Ralph Bossert and Gary deSzendeffy had an excused absence. Roll Call
- C STAFF PRESENT: Jon Cadd, Plans Examiner; and Chris Floyd, Secretary. Staff Present
- D APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Don Monteath moved, to approve the minutes of the May 22, 2007, meeting. James Garner requested that two changes be made that affect the May 8 and May 22 minutes. It is regarding the paragraph on page 411 of the May 8 meeting that reads; There was a lengthy discussion regarding the square footage requirement for residential fire sprinklers, the 600' rule for fire hydrant, and driveway/roadway access requirements. Adding the sentence, '*A request was made from Bob Lockhart to make suggestions dealing with Section 503.1.1 in the International Fire Code*'. The change now includes changing the word from Bob Lockhart to Bob Lockhart and adding a sentence to item E of the May 22 meeting that reads, '*Mr. Lockhart submitted by email, on May 11, 2007, his suggestions for consideration by the Building Advisory Board.*' Don Monteath amended his motion and James Garner seconded; motion carried 4-0. Approval of Minutes
- E Jon Cadd, Plans Examiner, presented the 2006 International Fuel Gas Code (IFGC). The Board asked questions, which were answered by staff. 2006 IFGC
- There was discussion regarding the type of gas burning appliance that would be allowed for use in a bedroom.
