There were no corrections on the May 2, 2007 Surface Transportation Advisory Committee Minutes. Member Schmidt moved to accept the Minutes. Second by Member Metcalf. Motion carried, 6-0. | Minutes

| G | Status report and update on street projects by the Public Works Engineer or his designee.

Mr. Garrett went over the current streets projects. Meadow Street, between Main and Frontier, is now a public street owned and maintained by the Town of Payson. Longhorn Road, from Walgreens to McLane, is going to be chip sealed with a new rubberized seal and will be re-striped to include a bike lane. Pavement Maintenance Program, slurry seal will go to bid next week. Slurry will begin end of July or first of August. There are approximately sixteen miles of road to be slurry and chip sealed. The design for the St. Phillips project is being completed. Mud Springs, from Frontier Elementary to Granite Dells, is out to bid, will receive bids on July 3, 2007. A Discussion/Possible Action concerning the alley on the east side of Highway 87 between Aero and Main Street.

Chairman Van Camp introduced the property owners that were invited to the public hearing to speak their opinions. Mr. Garrett explained this alley would fall under the Dirt Road Elimination Program. The Town wanted the property owners to know there is an option available to them. The property owners spoke their opinions and some of the owners are opposed to the improvement. Mr. Garrett explained the Town would need to have 100% property owner approval for the Town to accept and maintain. The Committee and the property owners discussed options and agreed to table this issue. Chairman Van Camp **motioned** to table this issue. Member Schmidt **second** the motion. **Motion carried, 6-0.**

The Committee discussed how they could get information out to the public and decided to go ahead and run a commercial on channel 4 and research the possibility to educate the schools, newspapers and radio. The Committee decided as a group to reach some of the radio stations. Mr. Garrett volunteered to address this issue when he is on the radio. Chairman Van Camp **motioned** to run commercial on channel 4 and discuss on the radio proper etiquette for bicycle and sidewalk use. Member Loeffler **second**. **Approved 6-0.**
