Recently, a Town of Payson sponsored Youth Advisory Council, named the Payson Advisory Youth Council (PAYC) was revived with the efforts of Payson Mayor Kenny Evans, Town Councilor Su Connell, and the Parks, Recreation and Tourism Department, in an effort to encourage and enable involvement of Payson's youth in Payson Town government and local issues.

The existence of a Youth Advisory Council is supported by Resolution #2292, passed 8-2-07, and Ordinance #733, passed in 8-2-07. However, there are specific desired changes proposed to better reflect the goals and objectives of PAYC.
