

ORDINANCE NO. 774

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, AMENDING SECTIONS 33.95 THROUGH 33.99 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. (PAYSON ADVISORY YOUTH COUNCIL)

WHEREAS, in 2007, the Town of Payson created the Payson Youth Advisory Council by adding Sections 33.95 through 33.99 to the Code of the Town of Payson; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Payson now desires to make amendments to Section 33.95 through 33.99 including renaming the Payson Youth Advisory Council the Payson Advisory Youth Council,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, DO HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Amendments to sections 33.95 through 33.99 (Payson Advisory Youth Council) of the Code of the Town of Payson set forth in Resolution 2536 were heretofore declared to be a public record by such Resolution, and all the provisions thereof are hereby referred to and adopted by this reference as though all the provisions thereof were set forth in full in this Ordinance Number 774.
- Section 2. That at least three copies of the amendments to sections 33.95 through 33.99 (Payson Advisory Youth Council), as adopted by this Ordinance Number 774 shall be filed in the Office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Payson and the same shall be maintained and kept available for public use and inspection.
- Section 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance Number 774 are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- Section 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance Number 774 is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance Number 774. The Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Payson declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance Number 774 and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion thereof despite the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, phrases or portions would be declared invalid or unconstitutional.
- Section 5. Whereas, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the Town of Payson, Arizona, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall become immediately operative and in full force and effect from and after the date of its enactment.
