

RESOLUTION NO. 2549

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, ADOPTING FEE SCHEDULES FOR THE PROVIDING OF FIRE, MEDICAL AND OTHER EMERGENCY SERVICES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON WHEN ALCOHOL OR DRUGS AND A MOTOR VEHICLE COLLISION ARE INVOLVED IN CREATING THE NEED FOR SUCH EMERGENCY SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the Town of Payson ("Town") provides fire, medical and other emergency services ("Emergency Services") within its corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, the Town may charge a fee for such Emergency Services; and

WHEREAS, in 2001, the Town established a fee schedule for such fire and medical services rendered outside its corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Town to impose charges for such Emergency Services within its corporate limits when the consumption of alcohol or drugs and a motor vehicle collision are involved in creating the need for such Emergency Services,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, DO HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Town of Payson incurs costs in providing Emergency Services within its corporate limits.

Section 2. In 2001, the Mayor and Common Council approved a fee schedule for the provision of emergency fire and emergency medical services outside the corporate limits of the Town.

Section 3. That the fee schedules attached hereto as Exhibits "A" and "B" are hereby adopted for the recovery of costs of providing Emergency Services within the corporate limits of the Town of Payson.

Section 4. That the Town be and is hereby authorized to charge and collect the fees set forth in Exhibits "A" and "B" hereof in every case when there is a motor vehicle collision and there is a reasonable suspicion that the recipient of Emergency Services violated any provision of Arizona Revised Statutes, Title 28, Chapter 3 at the time of the incident where such services are provided.
