

ORDINANCE NO. 787

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, AMENDING SECTION 50.82(B) OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON RELATING TO WATER CONSERVATION PLUMBING STANDARDS.

WHEREAS, on or about December 12, 2002, the Town of Payson adopted Resolution Number 1742 and Ordinance Number 620 establishing water conservation regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Payson has found that the adoption of this Ordinance is necessary and appropriate to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Town of Payson as a lawful exercise of police power vested in the Town by the State of Arizona; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and Common Council to amend Section 50.82(B) of the Code of the Town of Payson relating to water conservation plumbing standards,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, DO HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 50.82(B) of the Code of the Town of Payson be and is hereby amended, and as amended shall read as follows:

(B) Urinals. Waterless urinals shall be installed in all new public, commercial, multi-family residential common-use, and commercial and industrial building restroom remodels. Retrofits at such locations shall convert existing urinals to waterless urinals. Certain plumbing configurations (i.e., back to back) may benefit from the installation of an ultra-low flush urinal (16 oz. per flush) and will be allowed with the approval of the Water Superintendent.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
