

RESOLUTION NO. 2716

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, SUSPENDING FOR FISCAL YEAR 2013-2014 THAT PORTION OF SECTION 5.1.3 OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON PERSONNEL POLICY MANUAL REQUIRING PAYMENT TO EMPLOYEES OF CERTAIN UNUSED PAID TIME OFF.
(PTO ROLL OVER FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2013)**

WHEREAS, Section 5.1.3 (Paid Time Off) of the Town of Payson Personnel Policy Manual credits each regular employee with certain amounts of Paid Time Off (PTO) per pay period; and

WHEREAS, for employees hired before July 1, 2012, Section 5.1.3(D) provides for an annual pay out at half rate in December of each year for certain amounts of accrued, but unused PTO. Employees hired after July 1, 2012 are not eligible for any such pay outs; and

WHEREAS, because of financial constraints during prior budget years, the Town rolled over accrued, but unused PTO that would normally have been paid out in December (See Resolutions 2555, 2598, and 2666); and

WHEREAS, because of continuing financial constraints during FY 2013-2014 the Town desires to roll over such amounts of accrued, but unused PTO, that normally would have been paid out in December, in lieu of any pay outs,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, DO HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1a. The portion of Section 5.1.3(D) of the Personnel Policy Manual requiring the pay out (at half rate) of the first 96 hours of accrued PTO in excess of 480 hours for general employees hired before July 1, 2012 is hereby suspended for FY 2013-2014.
- Section 1b. The portion of Section 5.1.3(D) of the Personnel Policy Manual requiring the pay out (at half rate) of the first 134.4 of accrued PTO in excess of 672 hours for fire department shift employees hired before July 1, 2012 is hereby suspended for FY 2013-2014.
- Section 2. Any PTO that would have been paid out except for the provisions of Resolutions 2555, 2598, and 2666, and Sections 1a and 1b above, shall roll over to the 2014-2015 fiscal year for the benefit of the employee earning such PTO and shall not be forfeited.
- Section 3a. For the calendar year ending December 31, 2013, the portion of Section 5.1.3(D) limiting the maximum carry over of PTO hours to 720 for general employees hired before July 1, 2012 shall be suspended and the maximum carry over PTO hours for such calendar year shall be 1104.

- Section 3b. For the calendar year ending December 31, 2013, the portion of Section 5.1.3(D) limiting the maximum carry over of PTO hours to 1032 for fire department shift employees hired before July 1, 2012 shall be suspended and the maximum carry over PTO hours for such calendar year shall be 1435.2.
- Section 4a. For FY 2013-2014, the portion of Section 5.1.3(D) applicable to employees hired before July 1, 2012 providing that upon separation "All Paid Time Off between 241 and 816 will be paid out at half rate" upon separation for general employees shall be suspended; and upon separation, all PTO hours between 241 and 1210 will be paid out at half rate.
- Section 4b. For FY 2013-2014, the portion of Section 5.1.3(D) applicable to employees hired before July 1, 2012 providing that upon separation "All Paid Time Off hours between 360 and 1166.4 will be paid out at half rate" upon separation for fire department shift employees shall be suspended; and upon separation all PTO hours between 360 and 1704.0 will be paid out at half rate.
- Section 5a. For the calendar year ending December 31, 2014, the end of calendar year amount of unused PTO required to be paid out at half rate (pursuant to Section 5.1.3(D)) shall be the first 480 hours above 480 for general employees hired before July 1, 2012.
- Section 5b. For the calendar year ending December 31, 2014, the end of calendar year amount of unused PTO required to be paid out at half rate (pursuant to Section 5.1.3(D)) shall be the first 672.0 hours above 672 for fire department shift employees hired before July 1, 2012.
- Section 6. No part of this Resolution shall permanently amend the Town's Personnel Policy Manual.
- Section 7. The Town is hereby authorized to take such other and further actions as are necessary or appropriate to carrying out the provisions in this Resolution.
