

Getting started with digital titles from your library

On tablets, smartphones, and Chromebooks

Step 1

Install the free OverDrive app from your app store or from app.overdrive.com. The app is available for Android™, Chromebooks™, iOS® (iPhone/iPad/iPod touch), Kindle® Fire tablets, Kobo® tablets, NOOK® tablets, Windows® 8 and up, and Windows Phone.

Step 2

Open the OverDrive app and follow the prompts to sign in or sign up for a free OverDrive account.

Choose sign up using a Library Card Under Find your Library in the search box type Gila County then press Go

If you're under 13, select **I am under 13 years old** instead.

NOTE: You won't see these prompts on Windows Phone or in older versions of the OverDrive app. In those cases, skip this step and move on to step 3.

Step 3

You can see all the

titles available in the Collection. Tap or move your mouse over an available title, then select **Borrow**.

Step 4

Borrowed titles will appear on your **Bookshelf** (under your **Account**) on your library's OverDrive website. From here, you can:

Download/Add EPUB eBooks* and MP3 audiobooks to the OverDrive app.

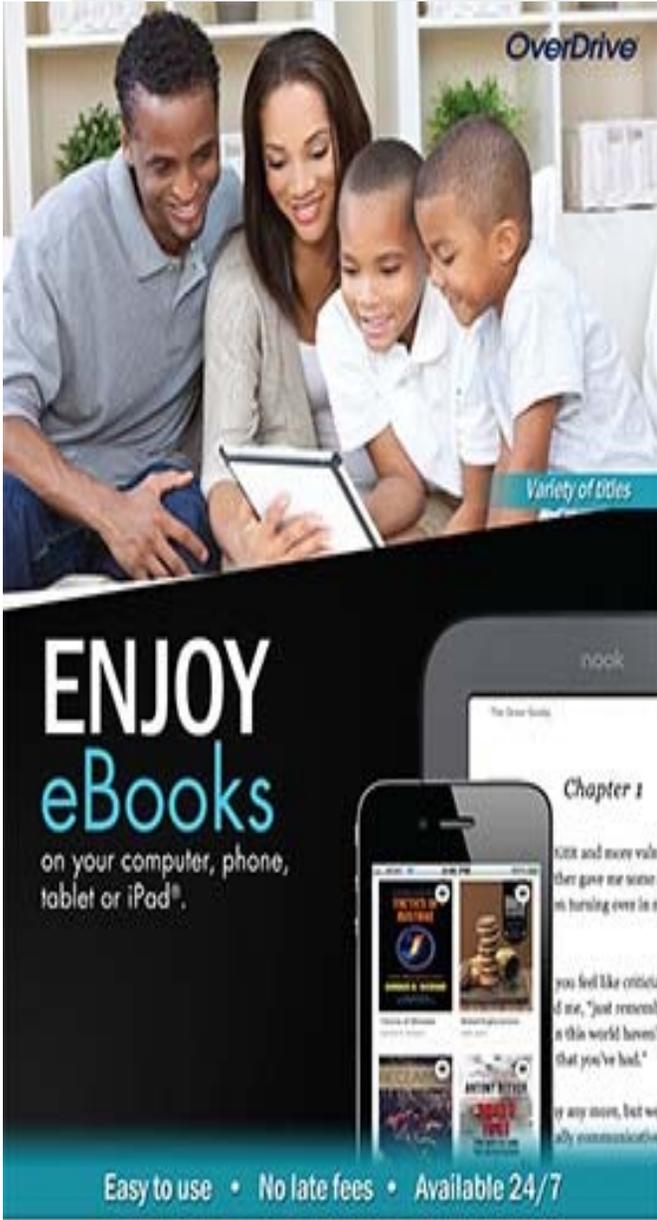
Read most eBooks in your browser without downloading them.

Listen to audiobooks in your browser without downloading them (on some devices).

Select **Download**, then select **Kindle Book** (U.S. only) to complete checkout on Amazon's website and send a Kindle Book to your Kindle device or Kindle reading app (on most devices).

***NOTE:** If you're using Windows Phone or an older version of the OverDrive app, you'll need to authorize your device with an Adobe ID to download EPUB eBooks. It's a one-time, free process that takes just moments to complete.

Getting started with eReaders

You can borrow eBooks from your library and transfer them to compatible eReaders using free Adobe® Digital Editions (ADE) software on your Windows® or Mac® computer.

NOTE: If you have a Kindle®, please refer to our guides on getting started with Kindle eReaders or getting started with Kindle Fire devices. If you have a NOOK® Color, Tablet, HD, HD+, or Samsung Galaxy Tab® 4 NOOK, please refer to our guide on getting started with NOOK tablets.

STEP 1

Connect your eReader to your computer.

STEP 2

Install Adobe Digital Editions (ADE) on your computer (get it from www.adobe.com/products/digital-editions.html).

STEP 3

On your computer, open your library's OverDrive website(<http://gclidaz.lib.overdrive.com/>) and borrow an eBook. Borrowed eBooks appear on your **Bookshelf** (under your **Account**) on your library's OverDrive website

STEP 4

From your **Bookshelf**, use the **Download** drop-down menu to select a format for each eBook (for the best experience, we recommend **Adobe EPUB** or **Open EPUB**, though many eReaders also support **Adobe PDF** and **Open PDF**), then select **Confirm & Download**.

If prompted, authorize your computer with a free Adobe ID (this is required for downloading protected eBooks). If you don't have an Adobe ID, you'll see a link to create one.

STEP 5

Downloaded eBooks should open in ADE. To transfer an eBook to your eReader, make sure you're in ADE's "Library View" you may need to click the **Library** button in the upper-left corner to get there). From there, drag and drop the eBook into your eReader, which should appear on the left under "Devices." Once you've transferred a library eBook, you can read it on your device just like any other eBook.

NOTE: During the transfer process, your eReader will be automatically authorized with the same Adobe ID you used on your computer.

NOTE: If you're using a Sony Reader and it isn't recognized by ADE, you may need to install and use the Sony Reader software to transfer eBooks. the Sony Reader software to transfer eBooks.
