ORDINANCE NO. 846

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, AMENDING CHAPTER 50:WATER OF THE PAYSON TOWN CODE AND ADOPTING SUCH AMENDMENTS BY REFERENCE.

(AMENDMENTS TO CHAPTER 50: WATER)

WHEREAS, Chapter 50 of the Town Code contains provisions relating to the Town's public water system; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 50 has been reviewed as part of the overall code review process; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires to amend Chapter 50 in accordance with such review; and

WHEREAS, Sections 50.60 through 50.69 of Chapter 50 are the Town's Water Conservation Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires to amend its Water Conservation Ordinance with some of the amendments to be effective immediately and some to become effective upon the availability of C.C. Cragin water in the Town's water system; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and Common Council, in addition to the amendments set forth in this Ordinance, to amend Chapter 50 of the Payson Town Code by reference pursuant to A.R.S. § 9-802,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, DO HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The amendments to Chapter 50 (Water) of the Payson Town Code set forth in Resolution 2767 were declared to be a public record by Resolution 2767, and the amendments to Chapter 50 are referred to and adopted by reference as though set forth in full in this Ordinance.
- Section 2. At least three copies of the amendments to Chapter 50 adopted by this Ordinance shall be filed in the Office of the Town Clerk and shall kept available for public use and inspection.
- Section 3. Section 50.99 of the Payson Town Code is amended and as amended shall read as follows:

§ 50.99 PENALTY.

(A) Any violation of this chapter for which no other penalty is

designated shall constitute a misdemeanor, and shall be punishable as set forth in § 10.99 of this code.

(B) Any violation of any provision in §§ 50.60 to 50.69 shall be a civil violation subject to a civil sanction not less than \$50 and not to exceed \$2,500 for each day that the violation continues. The imposition of a civil sanction shall not be suspended.
